Lattice

Nancy received such a pretty quilt in the mail. But the owner had forgotten to send her name, or if she did send it, the name had become separated from the quilt block itself. So Nancy chistened the quilt Lattice.

She said she could see the lattice work going across the bed with the pieces in between of flowered prints which would make her think the vines were clambering all over the trellis or lattice and making the porch a bower of beauty.

She felt that she could advise the use of large patterned print for the pieces since the trellis would set them definitely apart.

If she used white strips for the lattice she missed the pointed effect which comes at the center of the block where lattice strip meets lattice strip. But she felt that the loss was really a gain since she now had a uniform trellis effect over the bed which is lost if one half the lattices are made from one material and the other half from another.

She felt, though, that her quilt club members could use their own discretion in color and arrangement.

The members sent for the life-size pattern of this quilt block. You can get your copy by following the directions which appear at the end of this article.

Notice that no seams are allowed in the pattern so be sure to add one quarter inch on all sides when cutting the pieces.

Choose color fast material. Be sure that pieces are cut straight and true.

This quilt is best developed in an all-over pattern, although you might use a wide border of plain white to set off the quilt.

Use number sixty white thread to seam the pieces. Have a good knot at the beginning of seam which starts in one quarter inch from sides and ends of pieces.

Be sure to fasten the thread securely at the end of seam. This seam ends one quarter inch in and from the edges of the pieces.
